



RESOLUTION 2010 – 04

A Resolution to begin charging fees for all Fluorescent bulbs, Latex and Oil based paints, varnishes and other painting products at all District Household Hazardous Waste Collection Centers

For years, the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District has, from the public collected fluorescent bulbs and all types of painting products for free. There have been limits on the number of gallons of painting products that could be dropped off by individuals – these services were the individuals not affiliated or in business with painting contractors.

Due to the rising costs of properly disposing large volume of fluorescent bulbs (both the long tubes and the new Mercury Vapor cork-screw type bulb) and paints and painting products, the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District hereby, by a vote of the District Board, adopts the following fees when these items are delivered to the HHW Drop Off Sites in the District.

All latex paint and latex paint products will be \$1 per container (be it a pint, a quart, a gallon or a five-gallon container).


All oil-based paints and other flammable paint products – will be \$1 per pound, based on the weight, plus a \$1 per container fee on each can.

All fluorescent bulbs (no matter the length, size or shape) will be \$1 per bulb.

These fees are especially necessary in light of the District's change in vendors for the disposal of Household Hazardous Waste collection.
