



RESOLUTION 2011-01

A Resolution setting forth the 2010 Census Data as the official statistics for Boston Mountain Solid Waste District

Every ten (10) years, the U.S. Government sets forth new census figures as the official U.S. Census figures from each city and county in the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District has a vital need to use the U.S. Census population figures, as a correct base for various numerical calculations, and;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District shall utilize U.S. Census population figures, to plan for future and current programming needs. The U.S. Census data, rarely changes for the next 10 years; and,

BE IT RESOLVED, as there appears to be “no known inconsistencies” within the recently completed 2010 U.S. Census, these figures are thus, sufficient to set the quarterly membership assessment, starting in the 2nd quarter of 2011, for District members, Madison County and Washington County, as well as the cities of Fayetteville, Springdale, Johnson, Huntsville, West Fork, Farmington, Lincoln, Prairie Grove, Elkins and Tontitown, all other cities and communities and;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Official U.S. Census of 2010, shall be used to calculate and in conjunction with other District regulations, to possibly add to the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District Board membership, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District by approval of this resolution, on the 25th of February, 2011, hereby designate the 2010 Census totals as a guideline for structuring its membership; calculating present needs and planning for the future of the District.
