



RESOLUTION 2011-02

A Resolution calling for a Public Hearing on an Assessment Fee of \$1.50 per ton on all Solid Waste in the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District


Upon a Washington County Circuit Court judge's ruling in 2010, the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District has not received the previously approved Waste Assessment Fee of \$1.50 per ton levied on Solid Waste. A Legislative correction has been made to the language of the Arkansas law allowing for an assessment fee to be set on all solid waste generated or delivered into a Solid Waste District for the purpose of programming needs. And thus, a public hearing on such a fee needs to be held;

BE IT RESOLVED, The Board of Directors of the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District, by the approval of this resolution, are calling for a Public Hearing to be held on the matter of implementing a \$1.50 per ton Waste Assessment Fee on all solid waste generated or disposed of in the District; and


BE IT RESOLVED, The Public Hearing notice shall be published as a Legal Notice in newspapers of general circulation in both Washington and Madison Counties, as defined by District Regulations. The hearing shall be set for 10 working days following the legal notice appearing in the newspapers. Notice will also be sent to interested parties requesting notice of the hearing, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, The Public Hearing shall be held on a date and time set forth in the legal notice. Written comments will also be received by the District Director 10 days prior to the hearing and following the public hearing for a 20-day period. The Board of the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District hereby calls for the Public Hearing on the implementation of a \$1.50 per ton on all Solid Waste generated or delivered into the District
