
Notice has been received, dated Feb. 8, 2011, that a process to start the General Permitting process with the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality's Solid Waste Division, has begun;


**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District, acknowledges it has been five (5) years since the issuance of the last permit for its transfer station facility and that permit is set to expire, and;

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District, has every intent to make re-application for these permits issued under the current permit number: #0100-STSW-MC; AFIN 72-00778. Currently the District has both a Solid Waste Transfer Station permit, (Type TS permit) and a Yard Waste Compost Facilities permit (Type CY permit). The CY permit is not active at this time; and

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District, will be required to submit a Notice Of Intent to ADEQ in this process, along with a report from a Registered Professional Engineer; and various other documents and permit applications, to be classified as a Medium Capacity Transfer Station operating in the State of Arkansas;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Board of the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District, directs its administrative management and operations staff to take all the necessary steps to complete this application process for the future operations of the District. The Board will be advised on this permitting process until its completion. Approved this the 25<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2011.
