**A Resolution from the Executive Committee of the
Boston Mountain Solid Waste District Board, to the full Board, approving
a \$1.50 per ton Waste Assessment Fee in accordance with Act 209 of 2011.**

Following adequate legal notices published within the District and in Regional newspapers in accordance with rules of the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District, a Public Hearing was held on Wednesday, March 23, 2011, at the Fayetteville Public Library. Only one public comment was made, that being favorable to the passage of the \$1.50 per ton Waste Assessment Fee.

And following the publication of legal notices, the District also conducted a mailing of over 80 first class letters to all interested persons, businesses and corporations within the District and those immediately outside the District's normal business area, informing them of a proposed \$1.50 per ton Waste Assessment Fee was under consideration. All letters contained information for the public hearing and instructions on how to file a written comment on this issue.

Seeing no opposition, Maylon Rice, Director of the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District hereby offers to the Executive Committee a Resolution for approval of such a \$1.50 per ton Waste Assessment Fee. This fee, in accordance with Act 20-9 of 2011 will be assessed on all solid waste generated within the district; all solid waste brought into the District's borders from outside the District and on all solid waste generated within the District but transported outside the District boundaries to a disposal facility elsewhere.

BE IT RESOLVED, The Executive Committee of the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District, by a vote of this committee, hereby approves this \$1.50 Waste Assessment Fee and hereby offers this proposal to the full board at the next quarterly meeting. The fee shall commence being collected at the Eco-Vista landfill for waste generated within the district; and on solid waste disposed of in the Eco-Vista landfill from outside the District; and from haulers involved in the transportation of solid wastes generated within the district for disposal outside the district for disposal beginning May 1, 2011.
