



RESOLUTION 2011-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOSTON MOUNTAIN SOLID WASTE DISTRICT BOARD TO UPDATE THE FEE ASSESSED PER TON OF NON-EXEMPT WASTE

Whereas, The Boston Mountain Solid Waste District Board has an overall responsibility for the continuance of the services being offered to the citizens of Madison and Washington Counties for solid waste transfer, rural recycling, bulky pick-up service, household hazardous waste collection/disposal and enforcing the state's illegal dump control and littering laws; and

Whereas, The District provided a legal notice in the area newspapers and held a public hearing listed therein those notices on the 23rd day of March, 2011. After a 30 day-comment period the District's Executive Committee in light of a need to continue these services has approved a Waste Assessment Fee of \$1.50 per ton. This action, by the District By-laws, shall be brought to the full board at the next regular meeting; and

Whereas, Act 209 of 2011 states that a District Board may assess a fee on each ton of solid waste generated within the District delivered to a transfer station or landfill within or outside the District; or generated outside the District delivered to a landfill within the District for disposal; and

Whereas, Act 209 of 2011 exempts from fees non-municipal solid waste generated by a private industry and delivered to its privately operated disposal facility or shipped out of state, steel mill solid waste, materials removed from solid waste and processed for recycling, organic materials that are composted, waste tires and household hazardous waste

NOW: Therefore be it Resolved:

Section 1: The District Board hereby authorized the District to levy a fee of \$1.50 per ton on the non-exempt solid waste generated within the District and delivered to a transfer station or landfill within or outside the District for disposal and solid waste generated outside the District and delivered to a landfill within the District for disposal.


Section 2: In accordance with Act 209 of 2011 and the District's Rules and Regulations, 20.02, the total fee per ton of non-exempt solid waste shall be \$1.50 a ton.

Section 3: The District Board shall determine by interlocal agreement how the District will assess, administer and divide the non-exempt solid waste fee not to exceed the \$2.00 ton cap set by Act 209 of 2011.
