

## **RESOLUTION 2011-10**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOSTON MOUNTAIN SOLID WASTE DISTRICT BOARD HONORING THE EFFORTS OF STATE REP. UVALDE LINDSEY, FOR HB 1060, WHICH IS NOW ACT 209 OF 2011.

Whereas, The Boston Mountain Solid Waste District board has a responsibility to provide for the public health, welfare and safety of the residents of Madison and Washington Counties when it comes to solid waste, recycling and the proper disposal of household hazardous wastes, and;

Whereas, A Circuit Court's ruling in 2010 removed a necessary funding source for the District to maintain operations under an unintended consequence in the legislative intent for solid waste districts all across Arkansas, and;

Whereas, State Representative Uvalde Lindsey saw the critical need for Solid Waste Districts to have an income stream to continue day-to-day operations. He quickly, and unselfishly gave of his personal time, technical skills and expertise to write House Bill 1060, which became Act 209 of 201. He used his considerable talents and powers of persuasion in both the Arkansas House and the Arkansas Senate for a positive outcome on this bill of few, if any, votes to the contrary;

Now: Therefore be it Resolved:

**Section 1:** The Boston Mountain Solid Waste District Board will be ever thankful for Representative Lindsey's efforts.

**Section 2:** The Board today presents Representative Lindsey with a recycled glass award, recognizing him for his efforts on HB 1060 and Act 209 of 2011.

**Section 3:** The Board shall spread upon the written record of the District's history the words of gratitude for Representative Lindsey's efforts to assist not only the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District but Solid Waste Districts all across Arkansas.
