**Whereas,** The Boston Mountain Solid Waste District Board at its November 2011 meeting approved the expenditure of \$152,812 in Electronic Waste Grants via Resolution 2011-20, and;

**Whereas,** the District has accepted applications from Madison County Solid Waste and Recycling Center; the Washington County Office of Environmental Affairs and the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District; and

**Whereas,** the allocated funds can be used in a manner to assist in the collection and recycling of electronic items in the Boston Mountain Solid Waste District.

**Now Therefore,** with the approval of the board, the following attached grants will be forwarded to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality for processing.

Addendum to Resolution 2012-02

E-Waste Grant Proposals to ADEQ

**\$6,500 – Madison County – for a 10 x 30 storage building for e-waste collection**

**\$20,000 – Washington County – for purchase of a fork lift for electronics recycling**

**\$60,000 – Boston Mountain – for three years worth of Once-a-year events for electronic recycling (done in conjunction with Washington County and other agencies)**

**\$20,000 – Boston Mountain – for purchase of a fork lift for electronics recycling**

**\$35,000 – Boston Mountain – for a storage building for e-waste collection**

**\$1,000 – Boston Mountain – for pallet jacks to move e-waste storage**

**\$5,000 – Boston Mountain – for transportation of e-waste from collection sites to UNICOR in Texarkana, Texas**

**\$5,312.00 – Boston Mountain – for e-waste collection supplies, educational brochures and promotion of e-waste collection events and cleanup of e-waste dumps**
